

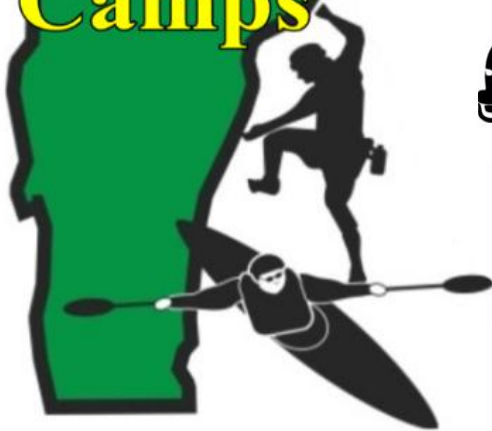

Activities at Camp

Kayaking Slow Moving Rivers

We go to many great areas to tour by kayak. Kayaks are perfect vehicles to spot wildlife or have an awesome afternoon. We also teach basic flat-water kayak paddling techniques, as well as correct ways to enter and exit your boat. Enjoy the wildlife and tranquility.

White Water Kayaking Instruction

We will fit you into a kayak and then we will head out to the White River or Sumner Falls. Both places are perfect for beginner kayakers. We will teach you how to paddle your kayak in small rapids and teach you all of the different techniques that you will need to know. If you want to break into the sport or just get out for the day to do something different this will surely be a thrill.

Multi Day River Trips

Kayak through the rural countryside with fine views of the marshes, mountains & meadows. You are most likely to see many covered bridges and wildlife on the paddle down the river. You will paddle until lunch time and then have a leisurely lunch on the banks of the river. There may be some portages to get around dams, etc. After lunch, we will continue to paddle the river. Once we reach a good camping spot, we will take out of the river and set up camp.

Hiking

If your outdoor interests are piqued by the prospect of hiking a diverse trail system over varied terrain, encountering panoramic vistas, breathing fresh mountain air, splashing in brisk alpine streams, and resting in forests abundant with wildlife, then you have come to the right place. Yes, New England is a wonderful place to hike and explore as well as SC. Each state we do trips in offers miles of woodland walks, hikes and trails in every region.

Overnight Backpacking Treks

Backpacking is for anyone, we will guide you on a trek through the woods. You can come with your own pack or use one of ours. We will go over what people have brought and make sure everyone has what they will need as well as leave behind things that are not needed. On this adventure, you will hike through the woods on the long trail, appellation trail and the summit trails just off from the main trails, experience the canopy of songs from wild birds in the big woods. It is always a great time to hike in the woods. The air is crisp and views are breathtaking. The essentials of backpacking will be taught. From hydration, setting up camp, leave no trace, pace setting, food preparation, and much more.

Rock Climbing Instruction

Our rock climbing is for beginner and intermediate climbers. This is the first step in learning how to rock climb. You are never too young or too old to start climbing. This course teaches participants the fundamental skills needed to participate in top rope climbing. Students will learn how to tie into the climbing rope, how to belay another climber on top rope, how to properly anchor themselves while belaying, and basic climbing technique. Climbing safety will constantly be stressed during this course.

Rappelling

Abseiling, rappelling in American English, is the controlled descent down a rope; climbers use this technique when a cliff or slope is too steep and/or dangerous to descend without protection. Abseiling can be dangerous, and presents risks; this is why our experienced guides will teach you what you need to know for a safe day out on the rock. You can choose to rappel 20 feet to 100 feet. You will have fun no matter what.

Gorgineering (VT only)

Welcome to the Northeast's version of canyoneering. VAC will take you down a gorge from the top to the bottom. We are the only Adventure Company to offer this trip. You will not find this trip offered anywhere else in the US. You will rappel into the gorge where you will be hooked up onto safety lines that we attach on the rocks in the river. From here you will stay on rope as you maneuver down the river. The currents are strong and we will show you how to safely maneuver over rocks and through holes. We ask all participants to wear sturdy shoes that you don't mind getting wet.

Biking Back Roads and Trails

Biking is for all ability levels, beginner to expert. We also offer mountain bike skill clinics. Each tour can be customized to fit your desires and to give you a great experience while you are with us. Riding skills, bike handling, exposure to various terrain surfaces, trail etiquette, and environmental impacts are all issues and topics you will learn.

Caving (VT only)

Explore one of the areas spectacular caves with us leading the way. This trip is not for people that are claustrophobic. You will go deep into the ground exploring the underworld. You will have to go through some very small holes to get to large underground rooms. We will take you to underground streams and waterfalls. You will see some spectacular rock formations.

Surfing Instruction

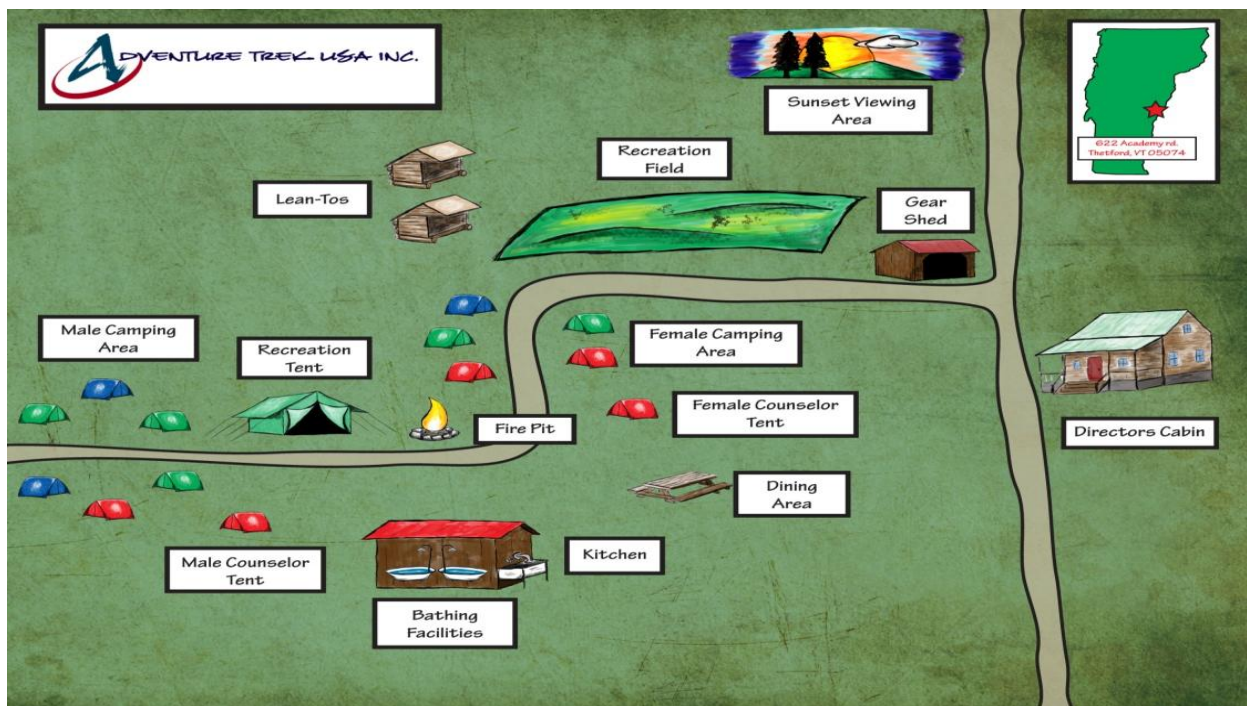
Whether you are brand spankin' new to surfing, just a little curious about getting out on a board you will find all the information and instruction needed to get up on a wave, up and riding...and ripping (note: ripping is good). We will need to leave early for Hampton Beach where you will be trying out surfing and spending the day at the beach. This is a great time and you may even learn to catch a big wave.

White Water Rafting

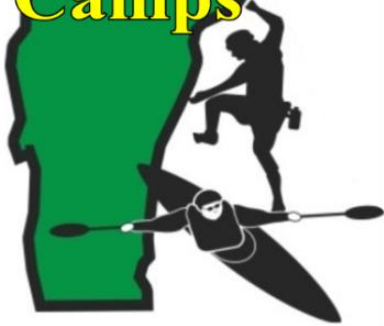
The class II and III rapids on our trip are ideal for beginner and intermediate rafters, and the unspoiled valley creates the perfect setting for wilderness adventure. Our 6-mile trip begins at Fife Brook Dam. Rapids such as Microwave, Freight Train, and Pinball allow crews to hone their skills in preparation for the raging Whitewater of Zoar Gap. We will have lunch on the river.

Sea Kayaking

A sea kayak or touring kayak is a kayak developed for the sport of paddling on open waters of lakes, bays, and the ocean. We kayak many ocean rivers and explore many islands while out on the ocean or large body of water.

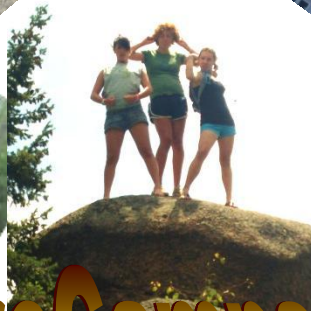
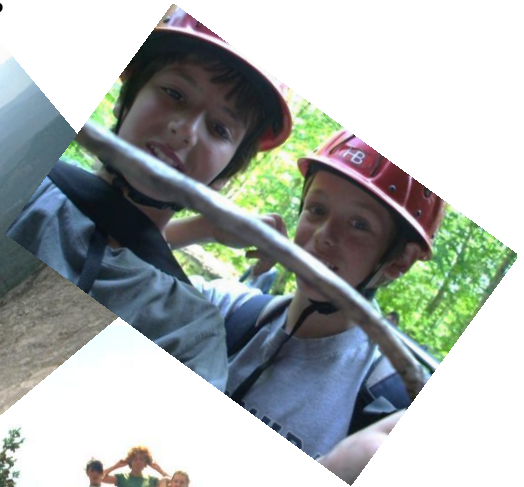

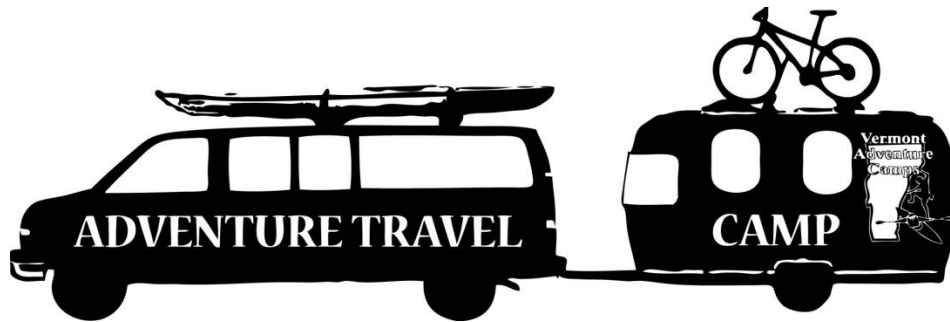
